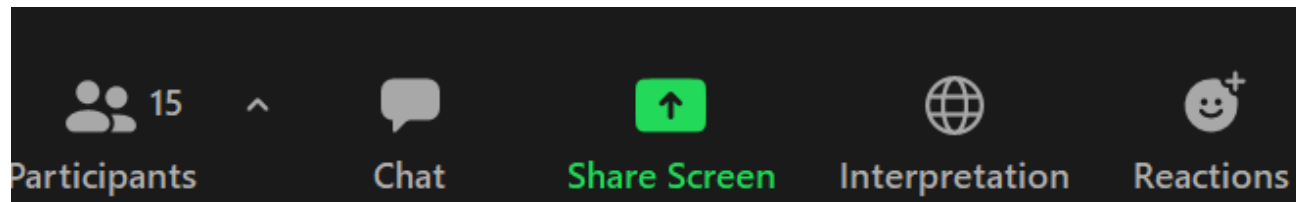

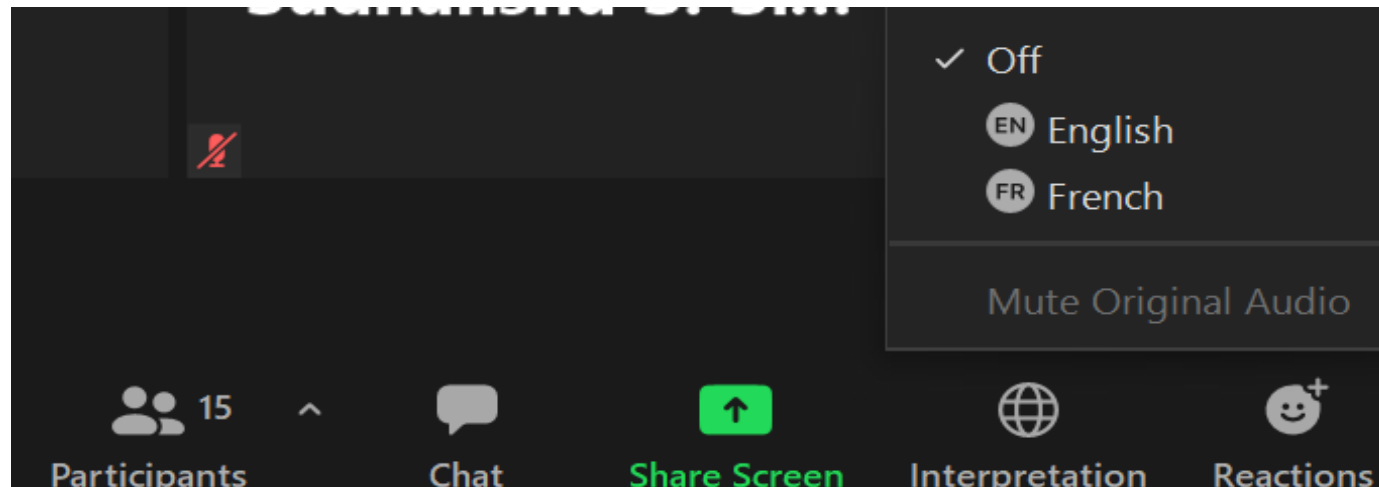
# How to access the interpretation / Comment accéder à l'interprétation en français

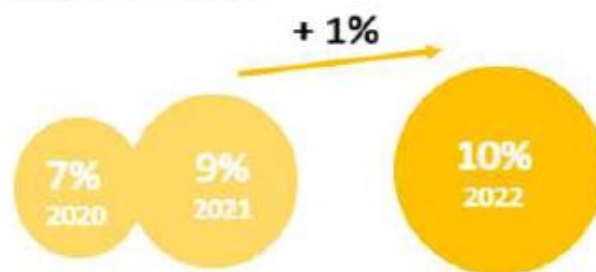

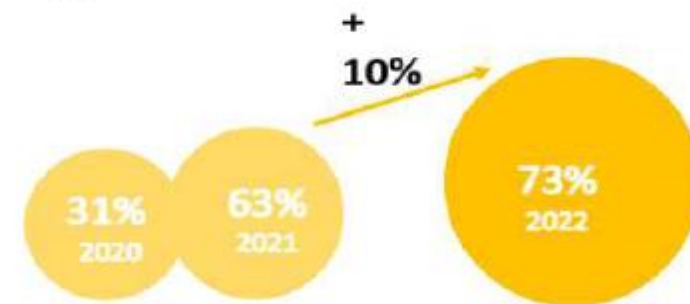

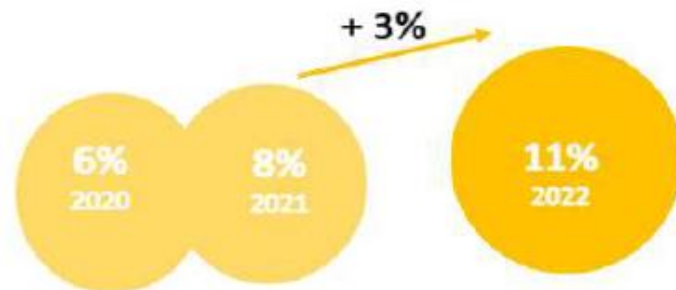
### 1. L/NAs on HCTs



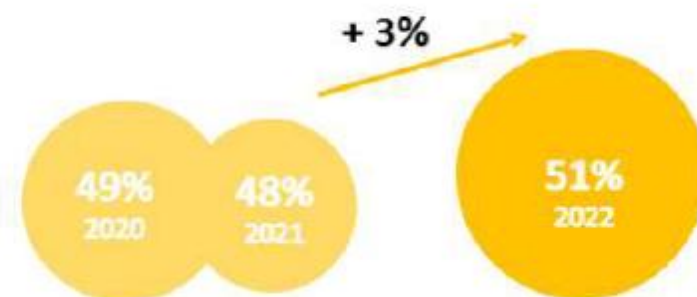
### 3. % ICCGs with L/NA members



### 2. L/NAs on ICCGs



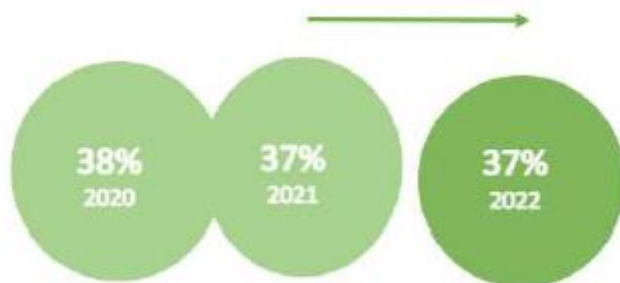

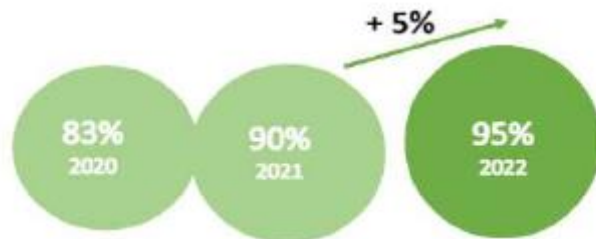

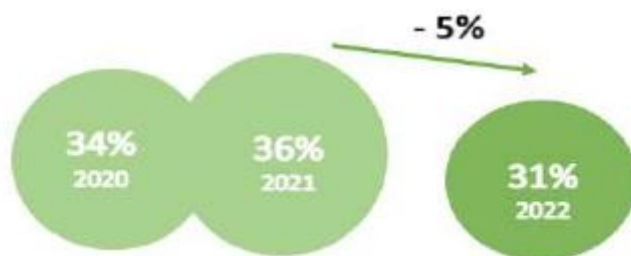

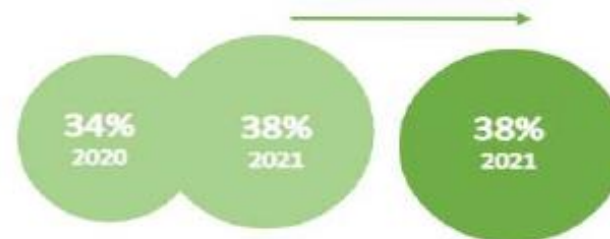
