### INFORMATION MANAGEMENT OFFICER

- > Manage information on nutrition needs, gaps, and responses.
- > Establish and support nutrition information systems.
- > Ensure timely and accurate reporting.
- > Design, and disseminate information products such as dashboards, need analysis, and nutrition cluster/sector websites.
- > Contribute to capacity strengthening through training and mentoring.

If your situation matches any of these, we're here to provide swift and effective support.

## Q WHO MAKES UP THE RRT?

Our team of experts consists of NCCs, IMO, and Nutrition Information Systems (NIS) specialists. With extensive experience spanning over two dozen countries, they're equipped to strengthen capacity in any crisis.

## Q HOW LONG CAN RRT PROVIDE SUPPORT?

In addition to short-term support – a few days to one week –, longer-term, virtual or in-person dedicated support is available within 72 hours of the request. For long-term needs, we can provide additional support through the standby partners mechanism and GNC consultants roster (Check [here](#) to learn more).

## Q WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

We tailor cost-sharing arrangements to each situation. The requested country's contributions are appreciated. If your resources are limited, you can still access other support mechanisms, such as virtual support or the facilitation of stand-by partners' support.

## Q DO I NEED TO ISSUE A CONTRACT?

No, but you must provide a Terms of Reference (ToR) with your initial request. Also, ensure RRT personnel are fully accommodated within your operation, including official UN ID cards, assigned in-country supervisors, security arrangements, induction, briefings, and necessary equipment and transportation.
